ARTS/CULTURE

COST

- 1. Awa Community Development Artists Group Community Mural Project \$190,000  
 Location: 67th & Dorchester  
 Project will repurpose underutilized space at the viaduct/underpass at 67th & Dorchester with a large scale professional mosaic and recycled materials mural artwork.
- 2. Restoration of Wall Murals Under the 56th St. Viaduct \$40,000  
 Location: 56th & Lake Park Metra Viaduct  
 Project will restore the mural at 56th & Lake Park Viaduct to its' original pristine condition.

CENTERS/SPACES

- 3. 71st Street Urban Garden \$120,000  
 Location: 2301 - 2307 East 71st  
 Project will serve as a point of contact for community involvement and as an educational opportunity. It will also produce quality food.

PARKS/REC

- 4. Jackson Park Track Safety Fence/Barrier \$50,000  
 Location: Jackson Park Track  
 Install six foot high fence between track and Cornell Drive to improve the safety for children playing in the park.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- 5. Improve/Repair Street Lighting at Metra Viaducts & Other Underpasses \$45,000  
 Location: 59th & Harper, 57th & Lake Park, 75th & South Chicago  
 Project will improve visibility, lead to an increased sense of security, and serve as a possible deterrent to crime.
- 6. Install New Security/Police Cameras \$22,500  
 Location: 68th & East End  
 Project will increase resident sense of security and be a possible deterrent to crime.

PUBLIC SAFETY CONT.

COST

- 2  7. New Street Lights \$448,000  
Locations: 68th & East End, Oglesby from 71st to 74th, Ingleside from 71st to 73rd, and 71st & Cottage Grove  
Project will improve visibility, lead to an increased sense of security, and serve as a possible deterrent to crime.

STREETS/PEDS

- 8  8. Curb Repair \$32,750  
Location: 2320/22 E. 70th, 2334/36 70th, & 7049/7055 Oglesby  
Project will repair cracks and holes in the curbs making the sidewalk and curbs ADA accessible and safe for walking.

- 7a  9. Resurface Dorchester \$21,600  
Location: Dorchester from 67th to 70th  
Project will eliminate reoccurring potholes and allow for fewer speed bumps on Dorchester.

- 11  10. Resurface University \$14,400  
Location: University from 55th to 57th  
Project will repair University eliminating its current cracks, holes and uneven pavement.

- 7b  11. Resurface Woodlawn \$7,200  
Location: Woodlawn from 71st to 72nd.  
Project will repair potholes on Woodlawn eliminating uneven pavement.

- 9a  12. Sidewalk Replacement Program/Safety \$32,750  
Location: 73rd from alley going west to corner of University  
Project will replace broken concrete making the sidewalk ADA accessible and safe for walking

- 9b  13. Street Safety on Cornell \$60,000  
Location: Cornell from 57th St & Lake Shore Dr. to 63rd  
Project will improve visibility on Cornell by painting dividing lines and installing reflectors.
